Create Your Own Podcast

Quick Steps

Step 1: Create your Audio File and Album Art Image

- 1. Record your voice in a program like Audacity.
- 2. Combine your voice with intro and exit music. Good place to find music is <u>http://freeplaymusic.com</u>
- 3. Save your completed audio file as an mp3.
- 4. Create an image to go with your podcast this is your Album Art Image. A good free program to do this in is <u>Paint.net</u>. I made my image 500x500 pixels and saved as a jpg.

Step 2: Save your Audio File

- 1. Your Audio file needs to be saved as an mp3 somewhere on your machine.
- 2. Download and install AudioShell.
- 3. Right click your audio file and choose Properties.
- 4. Choose the AudioShell Tag Editor.
- 5. Make sure everything is correct and attach your podcast image.

Step 3: Upload Audio File

- 1. Choose a Website to host your files. I had success with <u>http://www.gcast.com</u>
- 2. Upload your Audio file(s)
- 3. Grab the RSS feed

Step 4: Submit to iTunes

- 1. Login to iTunes Store
- 2. Click on the Submit a Podcast on the right
- 3. Copy the RSS (XML) feed in the box.




5. Go to Project → Edit ID3 Tags...

8. Save the audacity file so you have your beginning and end for each podcast!



Step 2: Edit your ID3 Tags

- 1. Download and install AudioShell http://www.softpointer.com/AudioShell.htm
- 2. Right click your MP3 file and choose Properties.





3. Fill in the Information under the AudioShell Tag Editor. Make sure to Add cover.

- 3. Click the Upload New Audio button on the left of the screen.






6. Get the RSS feed – click on the XML button

Step 4: Submit to iTunes

1. Open iTunes (make sure you are signed in) \rightarrow go to the iTunes store \rightarrow click on Podcasts



2. Click on Submit a Podcast



3. Paste your Podcast Feed.






4. Sign in to publish your podcast.

6. You will also receive an email that your podcast has been submitted.






7. If you want to see your podcast immediately: Go to Advanced ightarrow Subscribe to Podcast
